- ICAR is Society registered under The Registration of Societies Act XXI of 1860
- Under Rule 31 of the Bye-laws, the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, and the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules of the Govt in force shall apply to the employees of the Society.

Slide 2: Vigilance – What is it?

'Vigilance' means –

- to be watchful, to be alert – sense the happenings and what can happen; very essential word, not negative
- Raise your awareness level
- Dispel wrong idea of vigilance
- Vigilance influences all and all are vigilance people
- Vigilance is essence of Rules and a Management Tool; helps to be watchful
- All public servants should maintain probity and transparency at all times and is a pre-requisite for effective good governance
- Decisions should be taken in the best interest of the organization and without being unduly influenced by personal temptations, and insensitivity to wastage of resources.
- Organization needs to be protected from internal dangers which are more serious than external threats.
