

Trainers Training on Integrated Watershed Management Projects

Three-day (14 – 16 June, 2016) training of trainers on '*Integrated Watershed Management Projects (IWMP)*' was organized at ICAR-Indian Institute of Soil and Water Conservation, Dehradun in collaboration with MANAGE, Hyderabad.
