Irrigation and Green Water Conservation Techniques

Vasad, 19 January 2015. The Research Centre of Indian Institute of Soil and Water Conservation organized Field Day on "Irrigation and Green Water Conservation Techniques" for the



farmers of Nawad (Rewalia) and Navagaon villages, in PanchMahals district of Gujarat under the DST funded project. Forty-five farmers attended the field demonstrations, where irrigation techniques, viz. plough furrow, alternate furrow and furrow irrigation with and without surge flow were given live demonstration. Similarly, green water conservation techniques, viz. gravel mulching, residue (leaf) mulching and residue (weeds) mulching with crescent-shaped, V-shaped and saucer shaped micro-catchment around mango plants were demonstrated.
